Counting methods of residential sugar

°NM

The standardized must meter indicates the number of kilograms of sugar in 100 l of must (°NM). The scale is usually calibrated to measure at 15°C. Even with temperature deviations of up to ± 5°C, temperature corrections do not exceed ± 0,3°NM and can mostly be neglected.

$$0,732 \times \text{°NM} + 3,2 = \text{°KMW}$$

°KMW

The Klosterneuburg must gauge indicates the number of kilograms of sugar in 100 kg of must (°KMW). Degrees of oKMW are recalculated to °NM by multiplying by the appropriate must density value (e.g. 17,0°KMW x 1,083 = 18,4°NM).

$$\text{°KMW} \times 1,083 = \text{°NM}$$

°Oe

The Oechsle must meter indicates the difference in density of must and water, multiplied by 1000 (e.g. 83°Oe corresponds to a density of 1,083 g/l). The conversion of degrees °Oe to °NM is only approximate, density of the must is influenced by the sugar-free extract, which in good years represents an average of 2%, in bad years 3% of the content in the must (less sugar and more acids).

$$\text{°Oe} = 3,845 \times \text{°NM} + 10,8$$
